- He would be open to being taken for a criminal, Isaiah 53:9.
- "Then He opened their minds," 24:45k.
- "He had to die and be raised," 24:46-47.

The crux of the event lay in the prophecy of the _____ of sins.

- "It was necessary," "must be", 24:47.
- Our participation in the processes of heaven became real clear, 24:48-52, Luke 19:10.
- We have a holy task, a sacred trust, a joyous role in helping blind men and women see 24:46-48.
